ICE-SKATING PROGRAM

In January and February, we have the Ice Skating Program. This program is for children in Reception and up. We skate on Friday afternoons at the skating rink in Wislepark, Worb. (see the map below).

The skating program will run from 12:00 to 13:00 and all children will be at the rink at the same time. This means that **all children will eat lunch when they return from the skating rink**. The children should be sent with a healthy and filling morning snack. The children will be bussed to and from the rink.

Pick up will remain the same. If you wish to pick your child up at the skating rink, please do so at 13:00. If your child is not being picked up at the rink, they will return to the school and must be picked up by 15:00.

Please note the school will close at 15:00 on Friday

We kindly ask that only children who are enrolled in the Friday afternoon skating program participate. If your child is not ice skating for any reason, they must be collected from the school promptly at 12.00.

At the British School Bern, the students are taught to uphold the British School Bern values. These values are also expected to be upheld when our students participate in activities related to our school but away from school premises. Our students represent our school at all times. If a student's behavior in school or during the skating program does not meet the school's expectations, they may not be permitted to attend the skating lessons.

Required Clothing

All children must wear a helmet (no bike helmets please), waterproof gloves, snow pants and a warm jacket. Children bring their warm clothing, helmet, and skates to school in a bag, ready for the afternoon. A large plastic Migros or Coop bag works best as it is easy to pack and easy to carry. It is very important to label all clothing and equipment with your child's name.

Children who do not have skates at home, are able to rent skates at the rink. Parent will be required to send CHF 5 in a sealed envelope labelled clearly with the child's name and shoe size to the class teacher each Friday.

At the Rink

Once we arrive at the rink, children will change into their skates. Many children do require help with putting on their skates and tying them. Parents are invited to come to the rink to watch and help their child with the skating equipment. Please see the map below for directions to the skating rink.
